INVENTORY OF PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP PROJECTS

In accordance with Article 7 of the Public-Private Partnerships Act, Act No. 29 of June 8, 2009, we request that you submit to the Puerto Rico Public Private Partnerships Authority, hereafter the “Authority”, a list of proposals for potential public-private partnership projects in connection with any Function, Service or Facility, as defined in the Act, and for which your Government Entity (as this term is defined by the Act) is responsible under the provisions of its enabling act or other applicable laws.

The list of proposals for public-private partnership projects will be a part of an inventory that will be used by the Authority to prepare desirability and convenience studies to determine whether it is advisable to establish these Partnerships.

You should submit the list on or before Tuesday, September 8, 2009, so that the Authority can initiate the process to establish public-private partnerships. In addition, you should provide the contact information of the official in charge of implementing public-private partnerships in your Government Entity.

In order to facilitate the process of submitting project proposals, we include a Summary Table of Potential Public-Private Partnership Project (*Tabla Resumen de Proyecto Potencial de Alianza Público Privada*)—See Annex 1, where you will be able to summarize basic information about potential projects and which is also required for the initial evaluation by the Authority. The Summary Table of Potential Public-Private Partnership Project provides a mechanism to ensure that information is presented to the Authority in a uniform manner. You will be able to submit separate additional information to the Authority, should you consider it necessary for the consideration by the Authority. You may submit information for more than one project. Please fill out a separate Summary Table of Potential Public Private Partnership Project for each project.

I encourage you to consider the benefits for the Government and the opportunity to carry out public works and provide better services to the people of Puerto Rico by identifying and establishing public-private partnerships.
